

Domestic and Gender-based Violence

Evaluation criteria



Coherence

Assesses the degree of compatibility of the programme's support with other interventions in sector and institution.



Sustainability

Expresses the extent to which the benefits of the programme continue after the end of support.

Conclusions

The internal and external coherence of the programme was ensured to a high degree. The projects produced the synergies and links, which had a significant positive effect on the achievement of the program's planned objectives.

The programme and supported activities generated added value in four areas: i) content focus, ii) process setup, financing, and administrative complexity, iii) multi-institutional cooperation, and partially international cooperation.

Partial duplication with support provided under the Operational Programme Human Resources (Priority Axes 4 and 5) and national support schemes was identified. Currently, the programme's support appears to be most effective in the area of domestic and gender-based violence.

Project promoters appropriately plan and design projects in advance to ensure mandatory sustainability without significant risks. However, extensive legislative and systemic changes are necessary to ensure the long-term sustainability of the benefits achieved over time in the area of domestic and gender-based violence.

Recommendations

Maintain synergy between programme areas and their interventions. Expand target groups with a need for increased awareness of gender issues. Ensure that projects complement activities financed from other funding sources.

Establish regular communication between different support providers.

Support multiinstitutional cooperation as a mandatory element of projects.

Strengthen opportunities for cooperation with the Norwegian partner.

Support initiatives aimed at legislative and systemic changes.

Contribute to the transposition of the EU Council Directive.

Maintain the broad focus of calls for proposals.

Ensure financial, social and institutional capacities.
