Relevance

Assesses the extent to which the programme's objectives and design responded to the needs of the target groups.



Effectiveness

Assesses the extent to which the programme was able to achieve the planned results.

Conclusions

- The programme responded to Slovakia's main challenges in theareas of integrity, transparency, public administration efficiency, justice, and crossborder cooperation. The outcomes and outputs addressed the needs of the programme's target groups. The programme was able to adapt to the changing external environment.
- The relevance of the programme, its benefits for target groups, and synergies between projects were negatively affected by the thematic fragmentation of support and the administrative burden in the implementation process.
- The programme was able to meet or exceed most of its planned objectives. The quality of outcomes and outputs in key areas was high. Flexibility in implementation made it possible to cope with unexpected crisis situations (pandemic, war in Ukraine).

Recommendations

Maintain and further develop the flexibility of programme management.
